

Work Exchange Scholarship Application

The Sati Center for Buddhist Studies is committed to making our programs accessible to all qualified applicants. In this spirit, we offer work exchange scholarships to eligible applicants.

Scholarship Details:

- Scholarships apply to Buddhist Chaplaincy Training participants only
- Eligibility is based on financial need
- Scholarship recipients will receive a 50% discount off regular tuition rates. The remaining tuition must be paid by the 6th class (February).
- In exchange, scholarship students perform administrative tasks to support the training. These include classroom set up, audio recording of class presentations, literature reviews & research, and miscellaneous typing projects.
- Scholarships are applied to tuition costs only and should not be requested to offset expenses associated with travel, books and other program costs.
- Applicants must plan to complete the training
- Scholarship awards are made 1 to 2 weeks prior to the first class, which is often after interviews are completed.
